Los Angeles Poker Classic Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. What are the dates of the LAPC 2021?**
 - March 12 – 21, 2021

- 2. How many events are there? What are the buy-ins?**
 - Nine (9) No Limit Hold'em Events. Ranging from \$240 buy-in to the \$10,000 Main Event.

- 3. Are there any other tournament types besides No Limit Hold'em?**
 - Unfortunately, this tournament will be only No Limit Hold'em event. After we get this tournament out of the way we'll explore other types of games in future tournaments.

- 4. Are there any guarantees?**
 - None of the tournaments have a guarantee for them

- 5. Where will registration and then tournament take place?**
 - Registration will take place in the Fortune terrace cage area. Follow signage once on property.
 - The Tournament will take place in the big tent. Our outdoor set up is equipped with a heating and cooling system to combat the elements outside.

- 6. Are there any re-buys?**
 - None of the tournaments allow for re-entry.

7. What time does registration open and close for the LAPC Events?

- Registration opens daily at 10am and closes at the conclusion of level 5 (with the exception of the LAPC Main Event Day 2).

8. Can I register in advance for other tournaments?

- Yes, you are able to register in advance. Once a tournament hits capacity it will be sold out.

9. Why is there a tournament capacity?

- Since our outdoor gaming area is reduced from our indoor capacity, we only have a limited amount of tables available for the tournament area. Which then puts a limit to how many people can participate per tournament.

10. Will the final table be televised?

- No, The World Poker Tour (WPT) will not be involved with this year’s LAPC Tournament.

11. How many players will be allowed at a Poker table?

- Each table will be eight (8) handed between plexiglass dividers.

12. Why are there no food vouchers?

No eating or drinking is allowed at the gaming tables per the LA County Department of Public Health safety guidelines. A designated food and beverage area is set up away from the gaming area.

13. Are spectators still allowed?

- No spectators or standing behind players is allowed at this time.

14. Is your hotel open?

- No, the Crowne Plaza at Commerce is closed at this time.

15. Is your valet open?

- No, valet is currently unavailable at this time.

16. Can you smoke in the outdoor gaming area?

- No, smoking is not allowed in the outdoor gaming area. Two designated smoking areas have been set up away from the gaming area.
