GENERAL RULES

To register for a tournament and to collect tournament winning's. Commerce Casino Player's Card is required. To register for a Player's Card, players must possess a valid ID, such as a Real ID or Driver's License to US residents, a passport for non US residents, and an ITIN for those from treaty countries. A SSN or equivalent may be required based on the value of winnings. To comply with State and Federal regulations, the casino is obligated to withhold taxes upon the day of payout, and out of state residents are subject to tax withholdins on all winnings. Commerce Casino enforces TDA rules. House rules supercede TDA rules: No electronics on the felt (rail is ok), players may not interactively operate devices while they have a live hand. No use of gaming charts/tools/apps etc. while at the table or gaming area. Players are encouraged to call the floor if they witness any abusive, discriminatory, or disruptive behavior. Profanity is strictly prohibited. English only at all time while at the table. Play will start at a table with a minimum of 4 registered players. Pre-registration chip stacks will be placed out by the dealers. Single ante posted by the player in the big blind for the table for the entire event. Big blind is paid before the ante. Tournament ends at last player with chips or if players agree to divide the remaining prize pool at the final table. No chop/chip count or bubble will be facilitated. If players abuse the rules, they may lose the privilege of those rules. In bounty events; players receive the bounty amount when they knockout a player. *Players earn points for Player of the Series (POS) based on their placement (See POS official rules for details). 1. Total buy-in \$1,200; \$1,050 prize pool + \$150 Administrative fee. Administrative fee is not part of PP.
2. Players will start with 40,000 in tournament chips.
3. Levels will be 40 minutes for day 1.
4. The 4pm turbo flight will be 30 minutes for the first 8 levels and then 25 for remainder of day 1.
5. Levels will be 60 minutes for day 2 and day 3. 20 minutes when heads up (Last two players).
6. Registration is open until the start of level 10 on all flights (approximately 5:20pm for morning flights and 9:20pm for 4pm flight)
7. You may surrender your chips during the registration closing break and re-enter the tournament.
8. Surrendered chips will be removed from play.
9. Players are permitted to register and play multiple day 1 flights.
10. A player may unregister for a flight prior to play beginning on that day. Once play has begun, any player who has registered for that flight will have their chips in play and will not be permitted to unregister.
11. Each day 1 flight will play until 10% of the field is reached. These players will have their chips verified, bagged and will resume play on day 2 (9/28 at 11am).
12. Players returning on day 2 will need to show photo Id before they are permitted to resume play.
13. Players must qualify on any day 1 session to play on day 2. Play down to final table (9).
14. Starting blinds for day 2 will be the lowest blind level from the day 1 sessions.
15. The Tournament Director may add addition days.
16. Payouts - On each day 1, any player eliminated will not be in the money. 10% of the field will qualify and advance to day 2. Payouts will be posted at least 4 hours prior to play beginning on day 2.
17. Best stack forward - Players qualifying for day 2 may play another day 1 flight in an attempt to better their chip count. Players that have qualified more than once will play their highest stack. The other stack will be removed from play and the player will receive the minimum day 2 payout.
18. Forfeited chips will be taken out of play.
19. Any player disqualified from a day 1 flight for behavioral or unethical tournament practices will not be permitted to play in future day 1's and will also forfeit any day 2 stacks without payment.
20. There will be a redraw at the end of day 1, and on day 2 at 27 and the final table.
21. Tournament will be played using 2024 TDA rules. Commerce house rules prevail. Minimum number of players to start a new table is 4. Chip stacks will be placed out by the dealers for pre-registered players. Players that are given a table and seat assignment when registering will have their chip stacks placed out in a timely manner.
22. English only while at the table. No electronics on the felt (rail is ok). Players may not interactively operate devices while they have a live hand. No use of gaming charts/tools/apps ect. while at table or gaming area.
23. Tournament floor decisions are final. Players are encouraged to call floor if they witness any abusive, discriminatory, or disruptive behavior.
